Registration Steps for Returning Students



 Log onto your student center at my.maricopa.edu with your MEID (username) and password



 Click Add a Class link under Academics Heading and Enrollment Sub-Heading



 Select college and term you want to register for, and click continue



 Enter your 5-digit section number (found on your high school course list www.riosalado.edu/courselist) in the Enter Class Nbr field, then click the Enter button.



• Continue to add classes as needed



• Confirm your class schedule, then click the **Finish Enrolling** button.



2 PAY TUITION AND FEES

- Tuition cost is \$85 per credit* (subject to change) for Maricopa County residents plus a \$15 registration fee per semester.
 Payment is due upon registration. Students will be dropped from courses every Monday for non-payment.
- Pay tuition online by signing onto Student Center with MEID (username) and password. Click my payment options/ manage my payment plan and follow the steps.
