Cancellation schedule is as follows: \$250/person non-refundable; 75% refunded > 90 days prior to departure; 50% > 60 days prior to departure; 25% > 30 days prior to departure.

No refund < 30 days prior to departure.

Participation in this tour is subject to all rules and guidelines in the scholar handbook. All scholars must meet the following criteria in order to participate: Open only to 9th and 10th graders. Once scholar has met the requirement in the first sentence below, he/she must choose an option:

No scholar with a D or F at the end of the Fall Semester 2023, or with a major disciplinary referral will be allowed to register for this tour without teacher approval. Scholars who think they may eventually qualify should talk with their teacher chaperone before signing up for the tour and may be placed on an alternate list. Once qualified, scholars will be allowed to register if space is available and all money due to-date must be paid immediately. Payment for this tour will be according to one of two options:


Option 1. Scholars who have not been enrolled at Heritage Academy for the past two consecutive school years, or don't have straight A's on their transcript for all classes taken during that time will pay the full cost of the tour.

Option 2. Scholars who have been enrolled at Heritage Academy for the past two consecutive school years, and have straight A's on their transcript for all classes taken during that time may be eligible for an academic scholarship, and if approved will pay 75% of the tour cost. All scholarships must be approved by the principal.

Extracurricular Activity (ECA) Arizona Tax Credit Information

Hello Heritage families!

As your scholar considers participating in one of our upcoming study tours, did you know that the State of Arizona provides an option whereby you and other Arizona residents can help your scholar fund their tour cost through donations that then give the donor a dollar-for-dollar credit on their state income tax return?

Under Arizona law, Arizona tax payers can claim a non-refundable individual tax credit for fees and cash contributions paid to public schools (including charters) in Arizona for the support of extracurricular activities or character education programs.

The credit is equal to the amount of fees paid or amount contributed, dollar-for-dollar, up to \$200 for single or head of household taxpayers, and up to \$400 for married taxpayers that file a joint return. (ARS §43-1089.01)

The state tax credit is available to ALL qualifying individual Arizona state taxpayers. The donor does not need to have a child enrolled at Heritage Academy to take advantage of this state tax credit; as long as the donor is an Arizona resident they can donate.
