



PowerSchool Parent/Scholar Portal

About the PowerSchool Parent Portal

PowerSchool is a Student Information System (SIS) used to provide parents and students with the ability to review scholar grades, unofficial transcripts, and attendance records.

Parents can access the Parent Portal via a web browser or the PowerSchool Mobile app.

Accessing the Parent Portal

From any computer, tablet, or smartphone, parents can sign in to the portal at: <https://hamesa.powerschool.com/public/home.html>. The portal is also available on any Heritage Academy school's website.

Account Setup

Before logging in to the PowerSchool Parent Portal for the first time, parents must create an account and link their children to their account to access student information.

4. Select a unique username and password, which you will use to sign in.

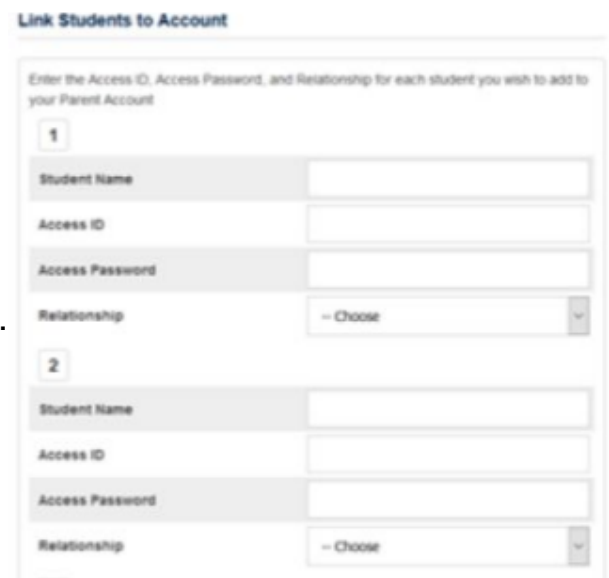
Linking Your Scholar to Your Account

To link or add scholars to your account, parents will need the Access ID and Access Password, which can be found on the Parent Portal printout your school provided to you.

Fill in the following fields:

1. Student Name
2. Access ID
3. Access Password
4. Relationship to child (Mother, Father, etc.)

Scroll to the bottom and click “Enter”.

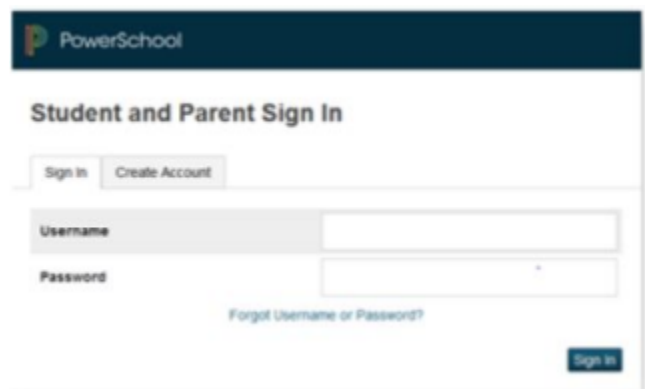

To log in to the PowerSchool Parent Portal, enter your username and password, then click “Sign In”.

Note: If you forgot your username or Password, click “Forgot Username or Password” and follow the prompts to reset your credentials. You should receive an email from PowerSchool with your username or a link to create a new password.

Grades and Attendance

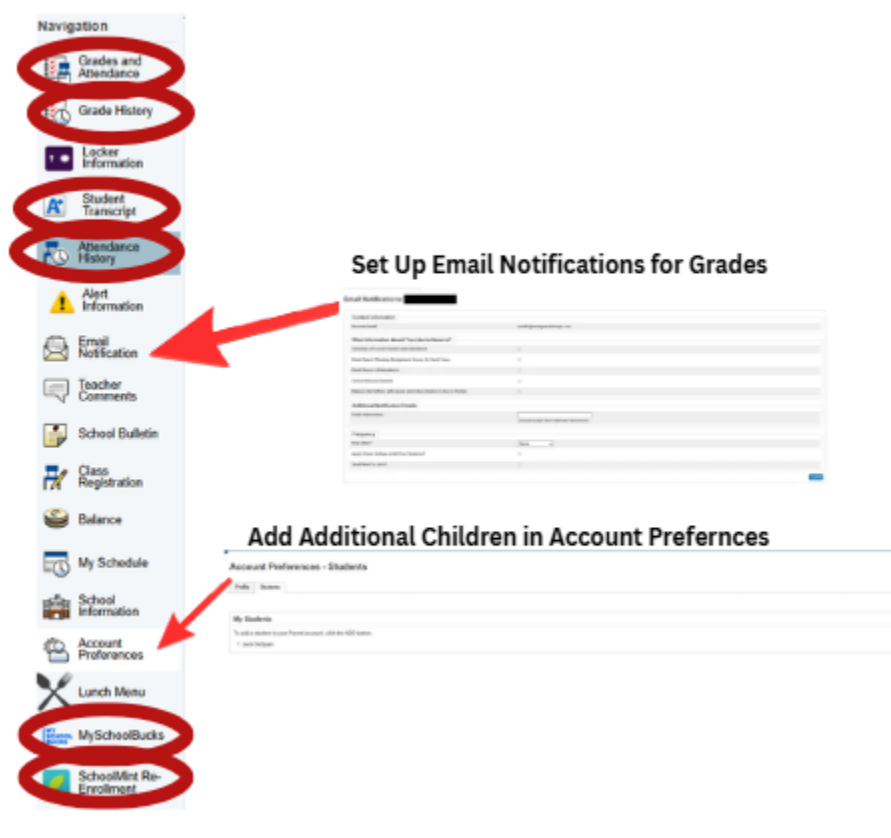

Additional Features

The left-hand menu provides additional features for the parent portal, including quick access to grades and attendance, grade history, attendance history or teacher comments. The menu also enables parents to access an unofficial transcript for scholars enrolled in credit-bearing classes, scholars' schedules, email notifications to set up grade alert emails, as well as single-sign ons for My SchoolBucks and SchoolMint Re-Enrollment.
